Maasai Mara

- ▶ Kenya's most iconic safari destination, but parts of it can also get crowded.
- ▶ However, very possible to get exclusivity by staying in the community conservancies where experiences like walking safaris and night game drives are possible. Also more authentic cultural interactions.
- ▶ Great wildlife sightings within a small area (when compared to the Serengeti).
- ▶ Variety of accommodations from boutique luxury tented camps (from camps with 4 tents to 30 tents) to private villas and exclusive use villas.





Laikipia

- ▶ Exclusive safari destination with the widest variety of experiences, especially walking safaris, horse-riding, camel safaris, helicopter excursions.
- ▶ Best place to see rhinos with great rhino conservation experiences.
- ▶ Successful conservancies where guests can experience the co-existence of wildlife, livestock and communities and learn more about conservation experiences – great for families.
- ▶ Variety of accommodations from boutique luxury tented camps to small lodges, exclusive use villas and exclusive use conservancies like Ol Jogi and Enasoit.





Samburu, Meru and Northern Kenya
